Re: 2026-2027 Cost of Attendance

Attached please find the 2026-2027 Estimated Student Budgets (Cost of Attendance) for your review and approval.

The last time that the *Cost of Attendance* was being updated or adjusted to reflect the changes that are taking place year after year with respect to the various elements that make up the cost of attendance such as tuition, fees, books, supplies, room and board, transportation, etc. was back in June 2025 for the 2025-2026 award year. For many two-year colleges and beyond, this is considered a norm. For our college, it is an opportunity to make such a revision to enable us to factor in the new tuition and fees rate, fluctuations in cost of living associated with the rising cost of goods, fuel and minimum wage hikes, as well as the associated cost, as required by Department of Homeland Security (DHS), to enroll international students. The new COA will take effect immediately for F-1 students and on July 1, 2026, when the new award year begins for resident students.

A combination of approaches and methods have been used in the revision process in deriving at some of the new figures, such as information on inflation rates, insurance rates, housing rates, personal interviews, International Counselor's input, bookstore personnel, peer colleges comparison COA, cost of rebuilding a new campus and to some extent, information drawn from personal experiences, observations, and assessments. The financial aid staff have also been consulted and provided valuable input and feedback. In the end, realistic factors or percentages were conservatively used in computing the amounts.

In these versions of the 2026-2027 COA, we have consolidated the Fall, Spring, and Summer Terms into the Calendar Year COA. And consolidated the Fall and Spring terms into the Academic Year COA.
