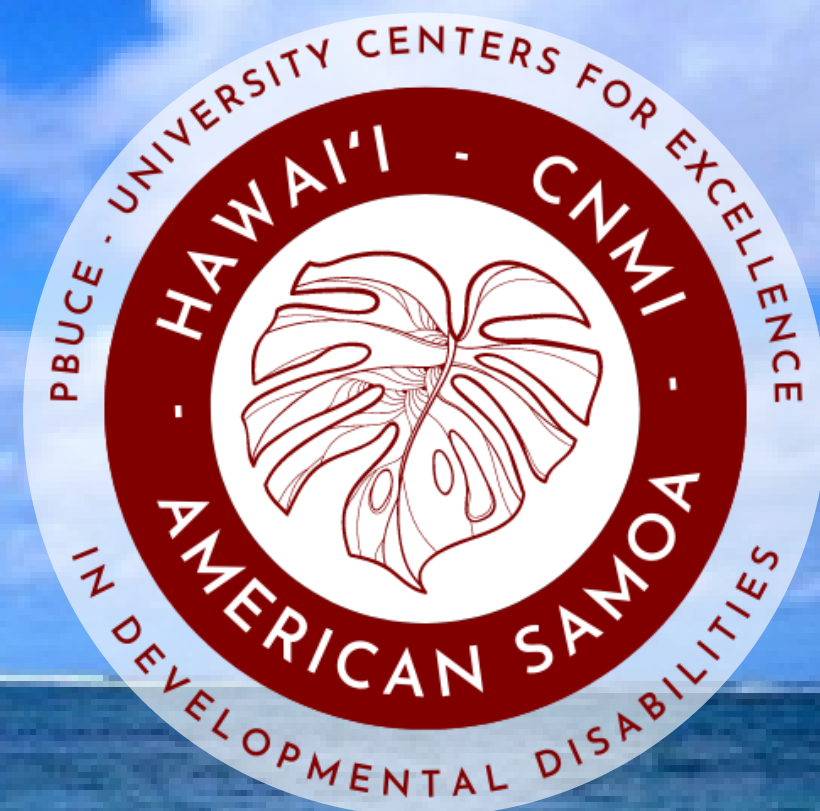

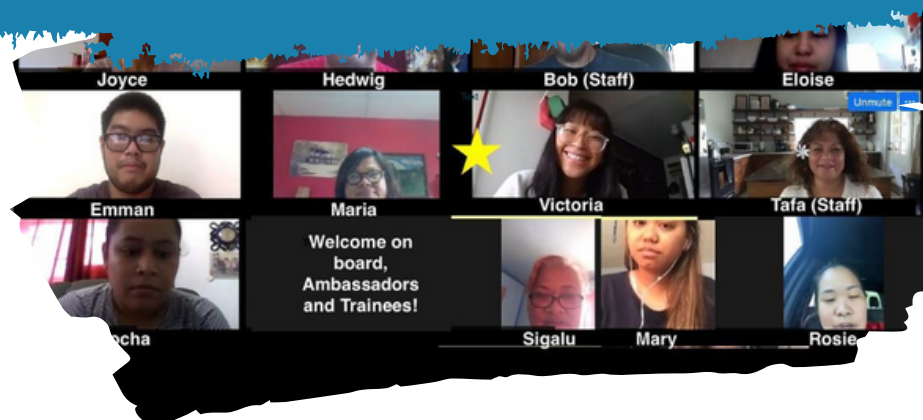

About the Program

UCEDD trainee program at the Pacific Basin University Center for Excellence (PBUCE) is to help train professionals and students to gain the skills and knowledge necessary to work with individuals with disabilities and become leaders in the disabilities field. Trainees have a common desire to continue learning about helping and working with individuals with disabilities, in particular, individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.



Program Duration

**Mid May - March 31,

Program Contents

- Coursework in disability studies from the University of Hawaii at Manoa.
- Monthly meetings and seminars.
- Service learning.
- Workshops in ASL, emergency and disaster management, etc. Assisting with research.

Eligibility

- Students or professionals who are from American Samoa or the Commonwealth of Northern Marianas Islands.
- Trainees - must have completed at least 1 year of Community College and have at least B or higher in English 100.

Program Contents

As a trainee, the trainee will:

- Gain an understanding of disability studies by taking a class on introductory disability and diversity course from the Center on Disability Studies at UH Manoa.
- Participate in a monthly seminar to connect with other professionals.
- Gain access to local and national resources on disability-related issues.
- Receive a certificate as a UCEDD trainee.
- Network with nationwide trainees.
